Kids Got Talent

Competition Rules

1. The Categories are 5 – 11 years and 12 – 18 years.
2. Applications will not be accepted without the signed consent of the performer's parent or legal guardian (except performer who are 18 years)
3. In the case of more than one performer in the act, the age category is determined by the eldest performer.
4. The maximum time limit for each act is 4 minutes, including set up time.
5. Individuals may audition/perform in no more than two acts. One being solo and one being duet, trio or group.
6. We reserve the right to refuse any act that we consider to be inappropriate for family viewing or may endanger or cause damage to the performer, audience, property, or building.
7. The maximum number of performers in each act is limited to 15.
8. Recorded lead vocals on backing tracks are not permitted; only chorus/harmonies are accepted.
9. We do not provide any equipment except hand held microphones (Max 3). All props , costumes, make-up etc. must be provided by the performers.
10. All music required must be provided by the performers on a CD. The CD must only hold the single track required for the audition/ performance and should be clearly labeled with the name of the performer or act. We do not accept responsibility for any backing track used in the competition. Recordings must be of good quality.

11. Additional auditions or qualifying stages may be arranged at our discretion.
12. Upon application, performers agree to video recording and or photographs being taken during the auditions, rehearsals and final show. These images may be used for promotional purposes and on The Lynden School of Dance website and Facebook.
13. Filming or photography is not permitted without permission from The Lynden School of Dance.
14. The audition fee must be paid with the application and is non refundable unless the event is cancelled.
15. All finalists are required to attend the rehearsal at Queen Mary's College, Basingstoke and stay until the end of the show – 1.pm – 9pm (approx)
16. All finalists are required to be in costume for the awards ceremony at the end of the show.
17. Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be awarded in each age category. All finalists will we awarded with a certificate.
18. The judges' decision is final and no discussion or correspondence regarding the results of the auditions or the final will be reciprocated.
