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# The Lynden School of Dance

## "Lynden for a lifetime..."

The Lynden School of dance has been established in Kingsclere since 1982 and has branches in Basingstoke & Overton. The curriculum follows The British Theatre Dance Association (BTDA) syllabus in Classical Ballet, Tap, and Modern/Jazz for children aged from 2½ years upwards. Pupils are regularly entered for exams and medal tests and are offered opportunities to compete in area dance festival competitions.

Special emphasis is placed on performing on stage. It aims to ensure that all students have the opportunity to perform in front of a live audience. This helps to give them greater discipline and confidence, as well as giving them a real sense of achievement that the whole family can share.

All pupils are invited to take part in our bi-annual 'Danceforce' shows which are staged at either The Anvil or Haymarket Theatres, Basingstoke.

Over the past years, pupils have been fortunate enough to dance at major venues including: The London Palladium, Sadler's Wells, The Theatre Royal, Her Majesty's, and The Royal Albert Hall.

Many former students have gone on to dance professionally in West End productions and pursued their career dancing around the world.
